

Above-ground granite vaults have been installed in the grounds of Boston crematorium in which cremated remains can be deposited. Each vault has space for up to 4 urns, and is sealed with a granite plaque containing an inscription to commemorate the deceased.

Each vault is leased for a period of up to 50 years upon payment of the appropriate fee which includes the plaque and inscription. When a second urn is placed in the vault the plaque can be replaced with an inscription to record both names jointly.

 Conditions of lease The lease holder will be notified in writing at their last known address shortly before the lease expires, and given the opportunity to renew it for further periods. If no response is received within three calendar months of the notice, the cremated remains will be reverently scattered within the memorial area of the crematorium grounds and the plaque will be removed and retained for six months. Please inform us of any change of address and advise us of any new contact should the leaseholder pass away. The lease period may be extended at any time prior to the expir of the lease term. Niches will only be allocated where cremated remains are to be deposited. They cannot be reserved in advance. The council reserves the right to refuse or amend any inscription if deemed offensive or inappropriate. The vases provided are for fresh flowers only. Other containers, plants, mementoes and artificial flowers will be removed, and retained for your collection. This measure preserves the available vase space for all visitors.
